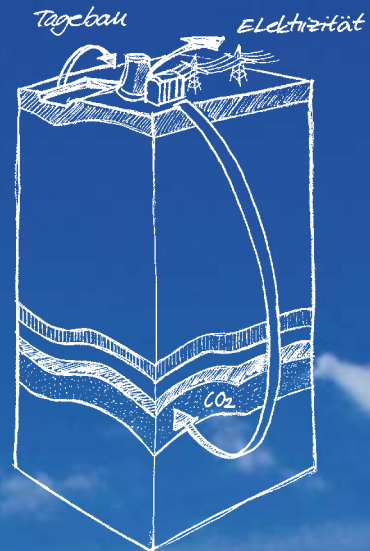


CCS: FROM THE LAB TO REALITY

Invitation to the Vattenfall International Congress on CCS



Climate change represents one of the greatest challenges of our times. As one of Europe's major energy groups and also an emitter of CO₂, Vattenfall has assumed unique responsibility here in its contribution to a more sustainable future for all mankind. In this regard one key technology that permits the use of fossil fuels with minimal CO₂ emissions is carbon capture and storage (CCS) - the separation out and geological storage of carbon dioxide from industrial combustion processes.
